

#### **HUISMAN LOGISTICS & WAREHOUSE REQUIREMENTS**

The requirements described in this document are applicable to all Deliveries made by a Supplier to Huisman Equipment B.V. (hereinafter referred to as "Huisman") and/or delivery locations appointed by Huisman, unless otherwise agreed upon and described on the related Purchase Order ("PO") document or frame agreement.

## 1. GENERAL DELIVERY CONDITIONS

The following general delivery conditions are applicable:

- 1. When exceeding one of the following specifications the Huisman warehouse team\* is informed in advance:
  - Dimensions exceed 120Lx80Wx150H cm;
    And/or
  - b. Pallet amount is greater than 3.
  - \* warehouse@huisman-nl.com, attach the packing list to the email
- 2. PO's are delivered when all ordered items are available, partial deliveries can only be done in agreement with the buyer, before the cargo is sent;
- 3. All packaging complies with the regulations of the destination country (e.g. IPPC/ISPM-15), unless specified otherwise in the PO's:
- 4. When items are ordered by Huisman on separate PO-lines, they should be delivered as separate items;
- 5. If the supplier converts single PO-line items into an assembly (one product), this is done in agreement with the buyer, before the cargo is sent;
- 6. All correspondence/documentation is in English.

# 2. ITEM PACKAGING

This is the packaging (e.g. box, bag or crate) of the item itself.

Conditions for an item specific packaging unit:

- 1. Each item (part code) is packed separately<sup>1</sup>;
- 2. When multiple amounts of the same parts are packed in one box<sup>2</sup>, the weight does not exceed 20kg;
- 3. Each box has a PO label specifying the total amount of parts of each item in it;
- 4. Each item specific packaging unit is marked with a Huisman Item Label<sup>3</sup> (Example: Appendix I), enclosed in the confirmation email of the PO;
  - a. The label is placed on the item specific packaging unit, in such a way, that it is clearly visible, when unpacking and handling it;
  - b. The entire text and barcode is visible on the label.
- 5. Packing materials (e.g. tape, carton, pallet boarders etc.) on this package do not show any supplier information (only acceptable if the supplier is the manufacturer);
- 6. If weight is higher than 20Kg, it shall be packaged in such a way that it can be handled by a forklift;
- 7. If a pallet is required, use euro pallets;
- 8. Blank surfaces are conserved corrosion proof (e.g VCI foil, Tectyl);
- 9. Foam transport chips may not be used;
- 10. If the item is not visible due to seal (e.g. plastic vacuum seal), a picture item is available on the package<sup>4</sup>.

## 3. TRANSPORT PACKAGING

If the item specific packaging is not suitable for the selected transportation method, make sure it packed in such a way that item is protected and conserved.

The following items are clearly visible on the outside of transport packaging:


- 1. Huisman PO number<sup>5</sup>;
- 2. Packing list<sup>5</sup> stating the contents for the specific package.

## Conditions for a transport package:

- 1. If weight is higher than 20Kg<sup>6</sup>, it shall be packaged in such a way that it can be handled by a forklift;
- 2. No more than 25 different items is packed in one transport package;
- 3. Foam chips packaging may not be used $^7$ .

# 4. MAIN TRANSPORT UNIT

The main transport unit is or contains one or more item and/or transport packages. This is the largest visible unit (e.g sealed pallet<sup>8</sup>) when physically receiving it. A transport can consist of multiple main transport units (e.g 3 sealed pallets).

Clearly visible/readable on the outside of the unit:

- 1. Delivery note;
- 2. Huisman PO number;
- 3. The gross weight on packaging and delivery note.

# Conditions for main transport unit:

- 4. If weight is higher than 20kg, it shall be packaged in such a way that it can be handled by a forklift;
- 5. If a pallet is required, use euro pallets;
- 6. Final shipment dimensions do not exceed euro pallet dimensions, unless an individual item exceeds these dimensions;
- 7. Foam chips packaging may not be used.

# 5. DELIVERY NOTE

Minimum requirements of the delivery note:

- 1. Huisman PO-number;
- 2. Huisman part code;
- 3. Delivered Quantity of each part;
- 4. Backorder Quantity of each part (if applicable);
- 5. Description of each separated item line, matches the PO;
- 6. Packing list line item is linked to PO line item number;
- 7. Huisman drawing number and position if mentioned on the PO line;
- 8. Dimension & weights, gross & nett;
- 9. Country of Origin of each part;
- 10. HS-Code for each part.

## 6. COMMERCIAL INVOICE (for customs purposes)

When passing through customs is part of the delivery, these are the minimum requirements of the commercial invoice:

- 1. Huisman PO-number;
- 2. Huisman part code;
- 3. Price of each part;
- 4. Delivered Quantity of each part;
- 5. Backorder Quantity of each part (if applicable);
- 6. Manufacturer of each part;
- 7. Description of each separated item line, matches the PO;
- 8. Packing list line item is linked to PO line item number;
- 9. Huisman drawing number and position if mentioned on the PO line;
- 10. Country of Origin of each part;
- 11. HS-Code for each part.

## International deliveries

In case the delivery of goods is outside of The Netherlands, please take into account the following instructions regarding our reference:

- 1. The referred client: Huisman Equipment B.V.
- 2. The delivery address: the actual address of delivery (e.g. Huisman (China) Co.,Ltd.)
